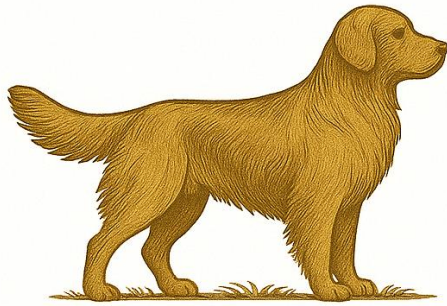

Before leaving for their new homes, every puppy undergoes a formal temperament assessment. This assessment helps us understand each puppy's unique personality, confidence level, energy, and drive. Rather than allowing families to simply choose based on colour or appearance, we carefully match each puppy with the family whose lifestyle and expectations best suit that puppy's temperament. We believe this creates happier families and more successful lifelong placements.

We are passionate about preserving the Golden Retriever breed according to the internationally recognised breed standard. For this reason, we actively campaign our dogs in breed shows, where they are independently assessed by qualified judges on their structure, movement, breed type, and temperament. Participating in shows allows us to continually evaluate our breeding program and ensure we are producing dogs that truly represent the breed.

Health is the foundation of every breeding decision we make. Every breeding dog undergoes extensive health testing before being considered for our breeding programme. This includes comprehensive DNA screening for inherited diseases, official hip and elbow scoring, and all recommended breed-specific health testing. Our aim is to give every puppy the very best opportunity to enjoy a long, healthy, and active life.
